## What is known?

- Most common sounds for the letters: $s, a, t, p, m, i, d, n, g$, $0, c, k, c k, r, e, u, l, h, f, b, l l, f f, s s, j, v, w, x, y, z, z z, q u, s h, c h$, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, er, ure, ay, ie, ea, oy, ir, ou, ue, aw, wh, ph, ew, oe, au, ey, split digraphs, soft c , soft g .
- That words can have split digraphs. If a word ends with letter e, the other vowel usually says its name.
- That the letter g can sometimes make a soft $g$ sound if it comes before letters e, i or y.
- That the letter c can sometimes make a soft c sound if it comes before letters e, i or y.
- The alternate pronunications for 'ow' and 'ea'.
- That the letter y can make the sound y , as in baby.
