- That the letter g can sometimes make a soft g sound if it comes before letters e, i or y.
- That the letter c can sometimes make a soft c sound if it comes before letters e, i or y.
- The alternate pronunications for 'ow' and 'ea'.
- That the letter y can make the sound y, as in baby.

Set 20: tch as in match; dge as in judge; kn as in knee; wr as in wrap; mb as in lamb

New decodable and High-frequency words: 276 words High-frequency words: become, does, doing, done, eyes, friends, laugh, laughs, more, thought, thoughts
